Visiting the Shaky Isles: Christchurch to Dunedin (NZ)

This year's conference is OHTA's third visit to New Zealand. It provides an opportunity to learn about the greatest destruction ever of organs in Australasia (the Canterbury earthquakes), to acknowledge achievements of the rebuild, and to visit the South Island.

The area covered includes Christchurch, Timaru, and Dunedin as well as several smaller towns. The tour includes around 30 organs by Jenkins, Bevington, Gray & Davison, Nicholson & Lord/Pearce, Hobday, Lawton & Osborne, Positive Organ Company, Hill Norman & Beard, and other builders. There will be three recitals, four lectures/presentations and visits to many buildings of architectural interest (particularly by Francis Petre).

PROGRAMME SUMMARY

Monday 26 September: Christchurch CBD. Registration 10.00am. Presentations on impact of the earthquakes on Canterbury organs. Two major instruments rebuilt / restored since the quakes: Knox Presbyterian (recital by Andrew Blackburn) and St Michael & All Angels. Evening concert by Cathedral of Blessed Sacrament Choir (at St Mary's).

Tuesday 27 September: Christchurch and surrounds. Visits to organs in Lyttelton, Kaiapoi, Merivale, and Ferrymead Heritage Park (Edwardian township).

Wednesday 28 September: Christchurch to Timaru. Visits to organs in Prebbleton, Lincoln, Darfield and Temuka. Visit *At Violino's Musical Farmstay*.

Thursday 29 September. Timaru. Visits to organs in Timaru and Waimate. South Island Organ Company factory visit. Recital in Sacred Heart Basilica.

Friday 30 September: Timaru to Dunedin. Visits to organs in Oamaru and Port Chalmers. Walk & lunch in Oamaru's Victorian Precinct (New Zealand's most complete streetscape of Victorian commercial buildings).

Saturday 1 October: Dunedin. Visits to Dunedin organs. Presentation by Andrew Blackburn in Otago Settlers Museum. Final shared dinner.

Sunday 2 October: Dunedin. Concert in Dunedin Town Hall by David Burchell, Dunedin City Organist. After the concert, the coach will return to Christchurch (leaving around 4pm, arriving around 10 pm); but many will prefer other options for returning home.

TRANSPORT AND ACCOMMODATION

The conference fee includes accommodation in Christchurch, Timaru and Dunedin (7 nights, Sunday 25 September to Saturday 1 October inclusive) and transport during the conference. There is an option to book an extra night in Dunedin on Sunday 2 October.

Participants must arrange their own travel to Christchurch and returning to Australia.
