As registration is on Monday morning you may need to book three nights, Sunday 29 September to Tuesday 1 October. We depart for Tanunda on the Wednesday morning.

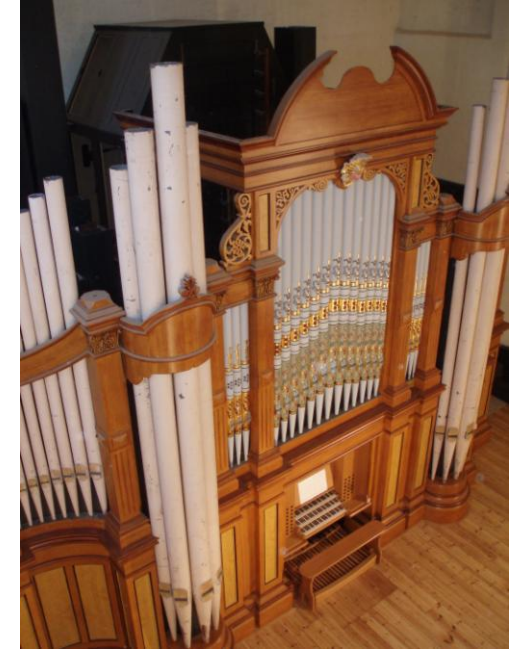

Broad Horizons - Looking Over the Hill

The 2013 OHTA annual conference will begin in Adelaide before moving to Tanunda in the Barossa Valley. The main focus will be on the 1875 Hill & Son organ at the Barossa Regional Gallery in Tanunda, originally built for Adelaide Town Hall. The restoration of this instrument will be celebrated at the conference through a range of activities including concerts and talks. There will also be the opportunity for participants to inspect the restoration work in detail and for trials of the instrument. Included also will be the input and work of others connected to the organ: John James Broad, the firm of Fincham & Hobday, J.E. Dodd and City organist W.R. Knox. Modern mechanical organs by Roger Pogson and Kenneth Tickell & Company will be seen. Our special guest will be Dr William McVicker, curator of the Royal Festival Hall and Reading Town Hall organs in the UK.

PROGRAMME SUMMARY

Monday 30 September: Morning registration in the hall of Pilgrim Uniting Church, Flinders St, Adelaide. Visits to organs around Adelaide and Norwood. Late afternoon lecture on W.R. Knox, city organist, with musical illustration at Clayton Wesley Uniting Church. Evening meal at the Monastery Glen Osmond.

Tuesday 1 October: Organs in the suburbs of Glenelg and the Port Adelaide area. Instruments by Dodd, Fincham & Hobday and W.C. Mack. Evening meal at the SA Royal Yacht Squadron with keynote speaker.

Wednesday 2 October: Travel to Tanunda via Moonta. Instruments by J.J. Broad at All Saints' Anglican and Moonta Mines Uniting Churches.

Thursday 3 October: Morning lectures. Visit St Aloysius Catholic Church, Sevenhill, Mintaro, and Martindale Hall returning via Hamilton and Kapunda. Evening: first recital for OHTA members and friends on the 1875 Hill & Son Grand organ.

Friday 4 October: An organised but flexible day to "Look over the Hill". Morning lectures and OHTA AGM with optional winery and regional organ visits being arranged. Public concert in the evening.

Saturday 5 October: Return to Adelaide via organs at Mannum (Pogson) Murray Bridge (Dodd) and Mount Barker (Dodd, Fincham & Hobday) to arrive at Adelaide Airport by 4.00 pm and Adelaide Hotels thereafter.

Note:

Coach is to arrive at Adelaide Airport by 4.00 pm – do not book any flights scheduled to leave before 5.00 pm. Transport to the Chifley Hotels in Adelaide will be provided.

The programme outline is fixed but details are subject to final confirmation and change.
