FREMANTLE: GATEWAY TO THE WEST

43rd Annual Conference

OHTA's 2020 conference focuses on the work of organ builders in the Fremantle, Perth and Avon Valley region of Western Australia. There will be the opportunity to explore the beauty of the region's undulating countryside and marvellous coastline, while also sampling of many gastronomic and viticultural delights that abound in the area.

We will visit significant instruments by Bellsham Pipe Organs, K B Blank & Zoon, François Delhumeau, J E Dodd, J E Dodd & Sons, Gunstar Organ Works, P J Elms & Co, A Fuller, Hill & Son, P F Hufner, L Kirkham, F J Larner, A Monk, A Pease, Pipe Organs WA Pty. Ltd., K Smenge, South Island Organ Company, JW Walker & Sons, E Wragg and Wurlitzer Company.

The programme will include a number of organ recitals, demonstrations, papers, a cruise on the Swan River, a visit to the spectacular Swan Bells (Perth Bell Tower) and the York Motor Museum.

PROGRAMME SUMMARY

DAY 1: Monday 28 Sep - Perth West

Registration and official welcome at Scots' Church, Fremantle, followed by organs in Mosman Park, Crawley and Karrinyup and a recital at Fremantle, followed by dinner.

DAY 2: Tuesday 29 Sep - Perth Hills

The delightful countryside reveals historic towns and organs in York, Northam and, finishing the day at Clackline Valley where we will enjoy a rural dinner. The OHTA AGM will be held at Clackline Valley Olives.

DAY 3: Wednesday 30 Sep - Perth Central

The day will begin with a river cruise from Fremantle, including morning tea, bringing us to

Perth city where we will explore the Swan Bells before moving on to cathedrals and churches in Perth. Return to Fremantle by public transport.

DAY 4: Thursday 01 Oct - Perth East

We will drive down the coast to Rockingham, then across to Kelmscott where we will have lunch. Next is Belmont to see two historic organs, and finally two city colleges. This will be a day of intimate and contrasting instruments.

DAY 5: Friday 02 Oct - Perth North

We conclude the 2020 Conference with a visit to another city college before heading to Guildford for two instruments before the Conference Lunch at the wonderful Sandalford Winery in the Swan Valley. The afternoon will end in time for airport transfers after 3pm.

ACCOMMODATION / MEALS / TRAVEL

Participants must arrange their own travel to and from Perth, as well as your own accommodation in Fremantle. There are many accommodation options available in Fremantle, however conference organisers recommend the Esplanade Hotel, 46-54 Marine Terrace, Fremantle. Please contact the hotel directly quoting the code "OHTA WA". Superior or superior twin room cost per night is \$165.00 (max 2 per room). Coach transport will depart from the Fremantle Markets on Day 1 and from The Esplanade Hotel, Fremantle on Days 2, 4 and 5. On these days the coach will return to The Esplanade Hotel, Fremantle. Participants will need to make their own way to the E-Shed, Victoria Quay, for departure of the Day 3 river cruise.

Dinner on Days 1 and 2, and Lunch on Days 4 and 5 are included in the registration. Fremantle abounds in dining options, which we encourage you to explore, for other meals.
