

ITINERARY

MONDAY 2 OCTOBER

TUESDAY 3 OCTOBER

Visits via coach to Beechworth (historic gold town) and Wangaratta and organs by Anderson, anon c.1850, Bevington & Sons and Henry Willis & Sons, also featured in a recital.

WEDNESDAY 4 OCTOBER

All day in Albury with visits to organs by Australian Pipe Organs, Hill, Norman & Beard, Letourneau (and a recital), and Geo. Fincham & Sons. Recitals and papers. OHTA annual general meeting. Evening visit to the mansion 'Adamshurst' anon organ c.1850 and catered dinner in the ballroom.

THURSDAY 5 OCTOBER

Visits via coach to Walla Walla, Alma Park and Wagga Wagga with organs by Fincham/Laurie, Laurie, Samuel Lewis, Noad and Geo. Fincham & Sons.

FRIDAY 6 OCTOBER

Visits via coach to Jindera, Corowa and Wodonga with organs by by Voskulen, Walcker and Laurie with lunch at All Saints Winery, Wahgunyah and a wine tasting at Morris Wines, Browns Plains.

ACCOMMODATION

Rooms have been reserved from the evening of Monday 2 October to the morning of Saturday 7 October at the Commodore Motor Inn, 515 Kiewa Street, Albury, NSW which is centrally located opposite St Matthew's Anglican Church.
