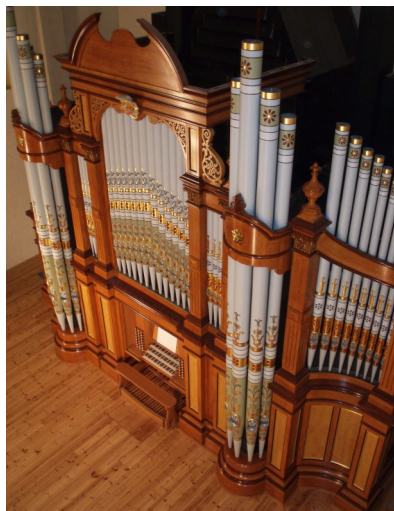
The Trust was founded in 1977 and has considerable experience in the field of conservation and restoration of pipe organs.

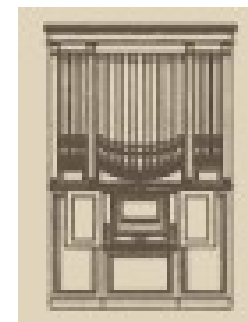


1877 Hill & Son concert organ

CONTEXT

The preservation of pipe organs in Australia, in which OHTA has played such a significant and pivotal role, has now reached a critical point:

- many churches are closing and buildings are being sold;
- organs often need to be relocated;
- some organs require storage;
- instruments of particular merit may benefit from being displayed and used in a museum environment.

PURPOSE OF THE FUND

OHTA seeks funds to further its purposes by initiating, developing and operating an Australian Pipe Organ Centre being:

- a facility for the storage of redundant pipe organs;
- space where these organs can be heard to good effect;
- a museum for rare instruments;
- a suitable arena in which concerts can be held;
- a venue with educational possibilities related to the organ, both trade and musical.

OHTA envisages that the Centre would engender:

- the greater possibility of on sale and relocation of instruments;
- Increasing and ongoing interaction with the community locally and beyond.

Additionally the Centre could provide:

- a space where archival material, books, journals and artefacts can be housed;
- accommodation for an on-site manager.

This is a Capital Raising Fund for the purchase, development, maintenance and administration of the Centre, and once the Centre has been established, funds can be used for projects specifically related to The Australian Pipe Organ Centre.
